2.6.2-Attainment of program outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution A.P.S.G.M.N.S. GOVT. P.G. COLLEGE KAWARDHA(C.G) 491995

1. Every semester or year, professor of concerned subjects introduces the course objectives (CO) in the section that relates to that subject.

2. Within the department the copies of the curriculum are kept. It is dispersed among students at the start of each semester or school year. Nevertheless, the syllabus is available for download by students via Hemchand Yadav University's website, www.durguniversity.ac.in

3. The Durg University syllabus and other pertinent material can be downloaded on the college website at https://pgcollegekawardha.edu.in.

4. Additionally, students receive explanations from the faculty members of each subject regarding the goals of the course, the grading system, and so on. Each subject's syllabus includes information on it as well.

5. The procedures for evaluating PO, PSO, and CO are as follows:

(i) Seminar presentations for post-graduate courses;

(ii) Quick tests or objective questions

(iii) Tutorials and homework at home Project work, if specified in the curriculum, such as extension work

(iv).Sociology, Political Science, and PGDCA, M.A.

For courses below graduate level:

- (i) monthly unit tests as specified in the syllabus;
- (ii) (ii) whiteboard presentations;
- (iii) (iii) Quizzes or objective questions, if applicable.
- (iv) Field/project work for environmental studies;
- (v) model examination; and
- (vi) Quarterly examination.

The results of the quarterly exam and unit test are entered into a registry. The university receives online uploads of the model and internal exam results.

6. The Institute gives students the chance to demonstrate their comprehension through written or spoken communication. The overall result of the exercise is that when evaluating, the assessment method does not become a barrier.

7. In light of this, certain extracurricular activities—such as quick lectures on specific subjects, rangoli making, lecture competitions, awareness/celebration days, Hindi diwas, Women's Day, Constitution Day, Voter Awareness Day, AIDS awareness, blood testing, Population Awareness Day, etc.—are subject and topic based. A learner gains confidence from these exercises since they enable them to communicate their knowledge in the best possible way.

8. The Institutes adhere to the above mentioned Hemchand Yadav University evaluation procedure. This kind of evaluation consists of external exams held at the conclusion of the course, contemporaneous evaluations, and term-end internal assessments.

9. The university's exams and outcomes also gauge students' attainment of CO, PO, and PSO.
